Dear Faith Formation Families,

As the new school year approaches, we are also preparing for the start of the Faith Formation year. We have some additional changes this year—staff with new assignments and new ways to help you and your child encounter Jesus' love through the beauty of the Catholic Church!

First, My name is <u>Alisha Schindler</u>, and I'm honored to step into the role of Area Director of Faith Formation and Youth Ministry for the Holy Family Area! I live just outside of Dawson with my husband, Clint, and our 4 kids- ages 3-13. Life is never dull-we share our space with a flock of chickens, a Highland cow, some Babydoll sheep, two ducks, and our three dogs. <u>MEETINGS</u>: Although the S-Term and J-Term meetings were well received in the past two years, it became a lot of meetings! Therefore, we will be condensing parent meetings down to the following:

- One (1) joint First Reconciliation and First Communion Parent Meeting/Student Retreat for those receiving those sacraments (one will be held in English and one will be held in Spanish)

nearby parishes, Advent and Lent Reconciliation, etc.

This does not mean that Parent Education events are not important, and it is possible they may return. Our youngest students will also be bringing home weekly notes on what they

learned and how you, as Parents, can learn alongside/with/from your children. Watch for these resources each week!

<u>DAY/TIME CHANGES</u>: We are making some changes to our timeframes at a few locations. Please read carefully through the attached schedule for <u>Grade levels and Day/Time changes</u> at our parishes. *Please note the enclosed calendar for your parish and keep this in a safe place for the entire year!

Catechesis of the Good Shepherd (CGS) for children, ages 3-6

CGS allows children to explore, discover, and take to heart the basic teachings of our faith; ponder Scripture; understand what is truly happening in the Mass; and enter into a personal relationship with God. This is all done through hands-on learning (no textbooks). It is a Montessori-style approach to religious education. Weekly sessions closely follow the faith formation and school calendars. This program is inherently liturgical, closely following the church calendar. You may now register your children for CGS through our regular Faith Formation process—ONLINE. Children can enroll each year from ages 3-6. (Because of limited space, we cannot accept paper registration forms.)

HOW TO REGISTER YOUR CHILD(REN)-- Faith Formation and CGS:

We will be utilizing an **ONLINE Registration through Google Forms**, which will help us keep all of your data up to date. Please use the following links to register your child at the parish where they will attend their classes (fill out one form PER CHILD). <u>Please complete ALL of the areas on the form</u>. (If you are in need of a paper form, there is one form included. Additional forms can be located in the back of each church. Students for CGS must register <u>online only</u>.)

<u>FEES:</u> Due to the rising costs of curriculum and shipping charges, and lack of previous grant-funding, all parishes will be collecting fees to help off-set the cost of the program expenses. Do know that we have checked Diocesan-wide, and we charge the LEAST amount of fees— and we want to keep it that way! **Please help us by registering your child(ren) online by September 1, 2025 for the discounted early-bird rate!** We have also eliminated the Sacramental Fees. Financial assistance is available.

CATECHISTS: We are in need of catechists at all parishes!

If we cannot ascertain enough Catechists for each grade level, home catechesis will be assigned. (This will also look different than previous home catechesis).

If you are interested in serving as a Catechist, you will be guaranteed the following:

- a) Full-time Catechists get **FREE Tuition** for your whole family!
- b) Learn a **TON** about your Catholic faith!
- c) Make a difference in the lives of our youth!
