In April 2016, at the tender age of 4, Eli Hansen was diagnosed with High Risk Stage 4 Neuroblastoma, a rare childhood cancer. He went through an aggressive 16 month treatment protocol that included surgery, chemotherapy, stem cell collection, 2 stem cell transplants, radiation and immunotherapy in the midst of more tests, scans and procedures. In summer 2017, there were clear scans and bloodwork, resulting in No Evidence of Disease. Eli continued with monthly clinic visits and labs, including trips to Michigan for what should have been a 2 year clinic trial for maintenance therapy. Then, on August 16, 2018, Eli and his family learned of a relapse of the neuroblastoma. The aggressive journey of chemotherapy and immunotherapy continue.
