Approval of meeting minutes: June meeting minutes approved

<u>Introduction of New Members</u>: Christine Baar, Barb Krumrai and Dick Strassburger. Current committee members introduced themselves.

<u>Baby Bottle Campaign</u>: October is Respect Life month; group (Life Connection) we worked with last year was disorganized and didn't acknowledge funds we sent to them. Will change to Women's Care Center for this year; Kate Burke will get in contact with them about display

Giving Tree: Tree will be put up weekend of Dec. 8 / 9; items due Dec. 17th and deliveries will be Dec. 17 / 18. Pewaukee Food Pantry would like their items early (12/16); will do an abbreviated collection for them. All agencies have been contacted and their updated with lists have been received or will be sent by end of Sept. Waiting to hear back from St. Anthony Girl Scouts re: contact to work with. Mary Sellers will be stepping in to assume majority of responsibility for the Giving Tree.

<u>Newcomer's Breakfast</u>: On Sunday Sept. 9th breakfast was well attended. Very engaged group and represented wide age range. Included singles, engaged couple, widowed, retirees and families. There were 67 invitations sent and about 48 people came; two couples registered with St. Anthony afterwards.

<u>St. Hyacinth Food Pantry</u>: Changing zip codes served in October. Served 86 new households last month; increase of 250 people served.

<u>Potential Partners in Mercy</u>: At June meeting, committee members were asked to research other agencies where we could incorporate ones that deal with refugees, human trafficking and mental health. Due to limited time for September meeting, will address more at October meeting. Kathy Libert & Jackie Timm: NAMI – mental health / identifying if at risk of suicide. Christine Baar: Mental Health America of WI – suicide prevention; WI Family Ties – parent peer specialist program. Christine Baar: human trafficking – Women's Center in Waukesha, Lotus, Empowering Through Beauty (unable to locate local agency). Susan Dowd: will present information on her research for human trafficking, refugees.

<u>Common Ground</u>: Fr. Tony requesting recommendation from Human Concerns Committee for Pastoral Council about issue he is being asked to spearhead. Issue is question about racial profiling by Waukesha County Sheriff of two black Baptist pastors with disabled vehicle on I-94 (in May) and how they were treated. Leadership of Common Ground called news conference outside Waukesha County Courthouse on Mon. 8/28; Gwen Mosier represented Common Ground (she is also on St. Anthony committee)

Two letters have been sent requesting a meeting with Waukesha County Sheriff's office, but no response

Committee members recommended taking a wait and see approach. In the interim, we'll draft / send letter to the two pastors stating that we look forward to the outcome of the investigation and let them know we empathize with them / apologize for how they were treated.

Goal for meeting is to begin to align our School Committee goals with the 5 strategic objectives of the Parish.

A main goal that was repeatedly discussed was that of Ownership – a triangle of ownership between parents, teachers and students.

• Ownership, responsibility, accountability of those 3 groups

A survey was given to all students in grades 4 through 8 asking them about their behaviors in the last 3 recesses. They asked about name calling, physically hurting another student, or excluding another student. These were given, answered anonymously, and the students had to answer yes or no. Rachel will be compiling the data to use as a measure of improving behavior and report to us at the next meeting. This survey will be done with the students three times per year to see if the efforts have helped.

- Rachel created a Mission Effectiveness Goal for the school year:
 - Through our intentional faith and school community, increased playground supervision and the implementation of parish and classroom covenants, we will reduce negative recess behaviors by 50% by May 10, 2019.

Angie and Lindsay are working on the behavior policy based on the needs of the school and the culture. This behavior policy will be in line with the Parish Covenant goals. They are going to be speaking with the teachers and staff as to what some current behavior issues/problems are and what is working and not working with those.

• Teachers/Staff want a clear understanding of classroom managements and what they can/cannot do for punishments. Want consistency.

Marketing efforts will continue as in previous years, as our younger grades continue to fill up. We'd like to focus on "community building" as well. We want families to stay here through 8th grade (improve retention) to keep our numbers up.
