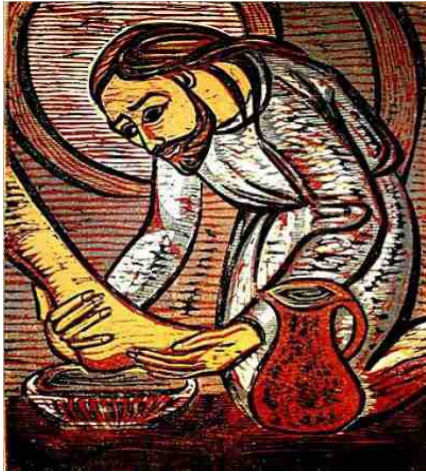


# St. Anthony on the Lake
