Younger siblings who are not involved in the practice may not stay to watch unless supervised by a parent. Parents are required to promptly pick up their child after the conclusion of practice.
- ▶ Emphasize the importance of participating at Mass by attending and singing at Mass!
- Assist the director when necessary for extra rehearsal and event supervision so that choristers are not left unattended should a student have to leave the rehearsal.
- ▶ Promote a spirit of friendship and cooperation among parents and students.
