

Food Donator Items 2020

Items to bring for the 2020 St. Vincent de Paul Meal Program

1. DESSERT – Cookies, bars, brownies, or cupcakes to serve twelve people. Please package cupcakes and items with frosting in a shoebox or other sturdy box because they are stacked for transport to the meal site. Purchased bakery cookies are well received.
2. MEAT SAUCE – Brown 2 pounds of ground chuck and place in a Ziploc bag for handling. Please place the meat in the parish refrigerator. Also provide two large plastic jars of Prego or Ragu spaghetti sauce. Please place the sauce on the counter when you deliver it to the parish kitchen.
3. MOSTACCIOLI – Two 1-pound boxes of mostaccioli noodles prepared al dente. Please toss with a small amount of oil to prevent sticking. Please package in Ziploc bags for handling.
4. DINNER ROLLS – Two dozen small baked dinner rolls. No ovens are used on the site.
5. SALAD ITEMS AND TOPPINGS –
First four people in the group: Two 24-ounce bottles of Hidden Valley Ranch (light or regular) salad dressings.
Next four people in the group: Two 1-pint containers of washed grape tomatoes.
Next four people in the group: Two 8-ounce containers of grated parmesan cheese.
Remainder of people in group: Two pounds of shredded mild cheddar cheese.
6. FRESH FRUIT -

January	20 washed apples or oranges
February	20 ripe bananas
March	Three 30-ounce cans of fruit cocktail
April	Three 30-ounce cans of fruit cocktail
May	20 ripe bananas
June	Three 30-ounce cans of peaches
July	1 seedless watermelon
August	1 seedless watermelon
September	Four pounds washed green or red grapes
October	Four pounds washed green or red grapes
November	20 washed apples or oranges
December	20 washed apples or oranges

7. MILK – Two gallons of 1% milk.
8. LETTUCE SALAD - \$5.00 donation for fresh lettuce salad. Please place money in box in parish kitchen.
9. BEVERAGES –
First six people in group: Two one-pound cans of powdered lemonade mix.
Remainder people in group: One two-pound can of regular coffee.
10. PUDDING CUPS – 24 non-refrigerated pudding cups, any flavor.
11. PAPER PRODUCTS or TRASH BAGS – Either two packages of paper towels OR two packages of toilet paper (8 roll per package) OR one box of 30-gallon heavy duty trash bags.
12. LAUNDRY SOAP – One bottle OR box of laundry detergent, SMALL size.
13. HYGIENE ITEMS – Either several sample sizes of shampoo, bar soap, deodorant or toothpaste OR one full size bottle of hair shampoo, conditioner, deodorant, or wrapped bars of soap.

Please bring all items to the Fellowship Hall Kitchen by 12:30 PM on Sunday afternoon. Items needing to be refrigerated should be placed in the refrigerator in the kitchen. Other items may be put on the counter in the kitchen. Labeling items with SVDP would be appreciated. Thank you.
