When you register at St. Anthony on the Lake, we will match your family with an experienced family who will contact you prior to the start of school and will be your own personal resource for questions about school (dress code, volunteer opportunities, schedules, extracurricular activities, etc.).

During the summer months, we host a social gathering for mentors and new families to give you and your student(s) an opportunity to get to know a few friendly faces prior to the start of school. We also host a casual get-together for new families and their mentors in the fall, to ensure you are settling into the school year well. Your mentor family will remain a resource for you throughout the school year and beyond!

CURRICULUM

Accredited by both the Archdiocese of Milwaukee and the Wisconsin Religious and Independent Schools Association (WRISA), St. Anthony on the Lake offers a faith and values-based education. Our superior instructional program emphasizes the mastery of basic skills throughout all academic and spiritual subject areas. Specific examples include the incorporation of phonics into our reading program and a hands-on science curriculum. In addition, our math program not only stresses the development of computation skills, but also focuses on problem solving, critical thinking, and the use of manipulatives.

St. Anthony on the Lake students consistently score above average on standardized tests and perform very well in their high school classes as we feed into several area high schools (Pewaukee, Kettle Moraine, Arrowhead, Oconomowoc, Waukesha North, Catholic Memorial, Pius, DSHA and Marquette).

TECHNOLOGY PROGRAM

Technology at St. Anthony on the Lake is constantly being updated and improved. Some of the latest updates include mobile devices for all students (1:1 Program), a large network expansion, and a transition to faster Fiber Optic internet connection. All school devices are networked and each classroom and public space has its own wireless access points to ensure connectivity.

A few highlights of Technology at St. Anthony on the Lake:

- Students from 3K to 8th grade enjoy use of iPads and/or Chromebooks. The 1:1 Program begins for students starting in K5 and devices may be brought home starting in Grade 2.
- Students use the Google Education Suite for productivity: Google Docs, Google Slides, etc. are used for writing and presenting, Google Drive for collaboration, and Google Classroom to connect with their classmates and teachers.
- St. Anthony on the Lake has a network that is protected by a business-class firewall and a security device that filters undesirable internet content.
- Each classroom at St. Anthony on the Lake is equipped with a Smartboard, allowing students to engage in active learning.
- Pre-K through 2nd grade students learn basic computer skills and practice classroomtaught concepts using math, science, language, drawing programs, and mobile apps alongside curriculum-driven internet research. Teachers engage directly with the students to provide modern learning solutions that are right for them.
- Keyboarding is taught starting in Pre-K and skills are reinforced all the way through 8th grade.
- St. Anthony on the Lake measures student progress with individualized assessments that provide data to the teachers in real time. These assessments help students, teachers, and families set personalized learning goals that meet the needs of the student and match the curriculum.

MUSIC AND BAND

Hands-on musical instruction is an integral and fun part of each student's experience at St. Anthony on the Lake. Each year, students participate in two all-school concerts and other community performances.



In addition to weekly music classes at school, beginning in 3rd grade, students have the option to join the St. Anthony on the Lake Children's Choir. The Children's Choir sings weekly at our School Liturgy as well as several weekend and holiday Masses throughout the year.

4th through 8th grade students have the opportunity to participate in the St. Anthony on the Lake Band Program. We offer both a Beginner and Advanced Band.

Finally, beginning in 5th grade through 8th grade, St. Anthony on the Lake students may elect to participate in the spring musical. Recent performances have included The Little Mermaid, Shrek the Musical, and Peter Pan.

ATHLETICS

Sportsmanship, leadership, and team play are the goals of St. Anthony on the Lake athletics program. Our program focuses on developing athletic skills along with enriching the social and emotional skills of the young people involved. Our coaches strive to serve as role models of Christian living and to teach our children sportsmanship and gracious winning and losing. We have a state-of-the-art middle school gym with 26' ceilings and two practice courts.

St. Anthony on the Lake Mustangs participate in volleyball, cross country, basketball and track beginning in 5th grade.

EXTENDED DAY CARE

St. Anthony on the Lake offers extended day care for our families. Two adults supervise the program on Monday through Friday from school dismissal until 6:00pm. The program consists of a supervised play period after school, followed by snack time, and then the children have the opportunity to study in a quiet study hall until homework is completed. There are crafts available to those interested and there are also a variety of inside toys and games that the children can enjoy.

FACULTY

Each faculty member at St. Anthony on the Lake is licensed through the Department of Public Instruction. In addition to our Principal and classroom teachers, St. Anthony on the Lake employs teachers for Physical Education, Spanish, Art, Music, and Band. Our 3K, 4K, and Kindergarten classrooms all have teacher's aides & we employ a floating elementary aide. Additionally, our staff includes IT Specialists, Resource Specialists, and Extended Day Care Supervisors.



RESOURCE SPECIALIST

It is the role of the Resource Specialist to offer remediation or enrichment to those students in need of further instruction. Remediation and enrichment are both provided in the classroom, through small group instruction, and/or on an individual basis.

Through data gathered in Measures of Academic Progress (MAP) and classroom testing, students are placed into quarterly "What I Need" (WIN) groups. These groups were designed in an effort to move all students forward toward their individual reading and math goals. Our Resource Specialist aides in instruction of all K5-5th grade students during the school-wide WIN block as well as aiding in instructing 6th-8th grade students during the middle school resource block.

Additionally, our Resource Specialist assists in screening students for various educational needs and refers students for further testing when needed. She leads the process on setting up Education Action Plans for students with differentiated learning needs. Education Action Plans could include modified curriculum, modified instructional strategies, and/or modified testing accommodations.
