What is the St. Anthony Scrip Program?

- Scrip turns everyday shopping into cash for our School and for participating families in the form of a tuition credit (applied to the following school year)
 - Families use retail gift cards to pay for everyday purchases (like gas and groceries) instead of the usual credit/debit card or other money
- School Fundraising Program Raised **\$5,213.59** *last year*
- Tuitions credits were **\$1,665.31** *last year*

How Does the Scrip Program Work?

- Our School purchases a wide variety of gift cards from merchants at a discounted price (1% – 16% less than face value; varies by retailer)
- Families purchase these cards at face value and spend them on every day purchases like any other gift card
- The School keeps the difference as a fundraiser and shares the proceeds with participating families in the form of a tuition credit

Get Involved!

How Can My Family Earn a Tuition Credit?

- Families will receive 50% of their total Scrip profit generated by their family's Scrip purchases throughout St. Anthony Scrip's fiscal year (July 1, 2019 – June 30, 2020).
- The School will keep the other 50% as a fundraiser.
 - **A minimum credit of \$5 must be earned to be applied to the following year's tuition.**
 - **Per family, the maximum tuition credit amount is \$599.00**

Potential Earnings Example

A family purchases Scrip on a weekly basis for grocery shopping, gas purchases, coffee runs and school Culver's night:

Potential Earnings Example

In just 1 week, this family met the minimum threshold of \$5.00 and put \$6.62 in their family's tuition credit fund for next year!

With weekly Scrip purchases, in 11 months, this family would have earned \$291.28 in tuition credits and earned the same amount for the School as a fundraiser.

Can you imagine how much money our School and your family could earn in a fiscal year if you regularly purchased Scrip for your own needs and for your relatives / friends / neighbors, for your business' needs, as gifts, etc.?

How Can I Purchase Scrip?

- **Option 1:** Volunteers sell Scrip after Weekend Masses, after School Masses, and after certain School functions such as concerts and open houses.
- **Option 2:** Print a copy of the Scrip Order Form from the school website (School -> Current Families -> Resources& Forms) and send a completed form with payment to school on Mondays. Scrip will be returned to you by Friday.
- **Option 3:** Scrip is available through standing orders (weekly, bi-weekly, monthly)

Payment options are CASH and CHECK MADE PAYABLE TO ST. ANTHONY SCRIP

How Can I Purchase Scrip Using ShopwithScrip.com?

Visit ShopwithScrip.com and set up your free family account using the St. Anthony School Enrollment Code - 28D14BL6897. Access to hundreds of retailers!

- **Physical cards:** just like what we sell after Weekend and School Masses
- **ScripNow eCards:** ordered on-line and printed right from your computer
- **Reload and ReloadNow cards:** allow you to put additional funds onto cards already owned

How Can I Pay for Scrip Purchases Made on ShopwithScrip.com?

- Check made payable to St. Anthony Scrip
 - Send a copy of your online order and payment in your SCRIP envelope to school. Once received, your order will be released for processing.
- PrestoPay made available from ShopwithScrip.com
 - Electronic debit through your checking or savings account
 - \$0.15 convenience fee per transaction
 - Set up PrestoPay capabilities right from the website
 - When you pay via PrestoPay, Reloads process faster, and you'll receive your ScripNow eCards and ReloadNow funds in a matter of minutes!
 - **NEW this year!** ShopwithScrip now accepts Credit Cards for Payment!
 - For a small convenience fee of 2.6% added to your order total you will have instant access to eGift cards and reloads.

What Can I Do To Get Started?

- Familiarize yourself with the SCRIP materials.
- Review, Sign and Return the Scrip Tuition Credit Contract
 - Must be received by December 31, 2019 or any earned tuition credits will be donated to the School.
