Tuition Policy Information for the 2021-2022 School Year

The parish community of St. Anthony recognizes that the Christian education of its children is a very important responsibility. The financial support of the school is shared by all parish families through regular contributions to the parish, and by school families through their parish support, tuition, and various fundraising activities.

The success and effectiveness of the school and its integration into the total parish community depend greatly upon the involvement of the parents, not only in the reinforcement of the religious formation that takes place daily in the school, but also by volunteering whenever possible, and supporting your parish in other ways.

Supporting Your Parish

It is expected that each school family will:

1. Attend Sunday Mass with your child/ren.
2. Participate in parish activities.
3. Volunteer at least 40 hours for school or parish activities such as School Committee, fund-raising efforts, or a ministry at Liturgy.
4. Contribute to the parish over and above the amount of your school tuition (tuition covers approximately 65% of the cost per student).

TADS*

St. Anthony on the Lake School has retained TADS for tuition collection and financial aid assistance. Families are required to register with TADS each year.

* We are currently evaluating our options for tuition management companies. More information will be forthcoming, and parents will be notified.

Tuition Payment Schedule

Payments begin in July and end in April. Payments will be due on the 5th of the month.

Families are offered single, biannual, quarterly, and monthly payment options.

Tuition Rates

Tuition rates for this school year are approved by the School Committee and Parish Finance Committee. See Tuition Fee and Commitment sheet for details

Fees

All fees are incorporated into the tuition amount. Registration fees are non-refundable. All fees apply to both parish families and non-parish families.

Non-Parish Families

Tuition costs for non-parish members are based on actual per-student costs.

Tuition Assistance

Families requesting assistance must complete an aid application through TADS. If you are currently receiving tuition assistance, please be aware that you must reapply each year.

SCRIP Credits

Families can receive 50% of their total Scrip profit generated by their Scrip purchases from July 1, 2020 – June 30, 2021. The School will keep the other 50% as a fundraiser. **A minimum credit of \$5.00 must be earned to be applied to your 2021- 2022 tuition.**
