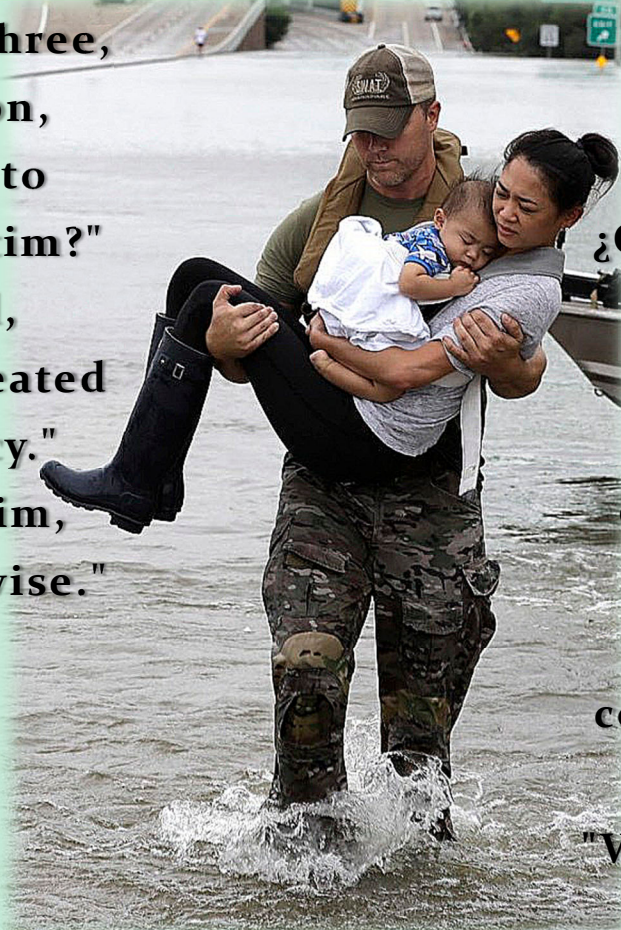

It is a common practice before eating a meal, beginning a parish meeting, or engaging in a sporting contest, that the participants gather for prayer. Its purpose is to be centered, in Christ, to foster a spirit of gratitude, openness, and spiritual energy necessary for the task at hand. It makes the necessary connections that centers our faith-community in Christ.

This is the Church's intention for us on Sundays. Weekly Reflection

Seeking the Samaritan's Heart

Today's readings and prayers challenge us to ensure that the words we profess to believe become the actions of our lives. In the Gospel, a scholar of the law identifies the two great commandments as the means to gain eternal life. Jesus affirms the scholar's words and tells him, "Do this and you will live." When the scholar presses Jesus for a definition of "neighbor," Jesus tells the story of a traveler, who "had fallen victim to robbers." He was stripped, beaten, and left to die. His situation was a "messy one" – one that none of the three travelers, a priest, a Levi, and a Samaritan anticipated encountering. When both the priest and the Levi see the victim, they cross to the other side of the road and hurry on their way. Rather than ignoring the injured man, the Samaritan bound his wounds, transported him, and paid for his continued care. After finishing the parable, Jesus asks the scholar, "Which of these three was neighbor to the robbers' victim?" After the scholar answers, "The one who treated him with mercy," Jesus directs the scholar to "Go and do likewise." We too must "go and do likewise." We proclaim in the Responsorial Psalm, "Your words, Lord, are Spirit and Life." If indeed they are, then we must ensure that they are actualized. Moses speaks to this point in the reading from Deuteronomy. He reminds the Israelites, "that God's command that I enjoin on you today is not too mysterious and remote for you. . . It is something very near to you, already in your mouths and in your hearts; you have only to carry it out." This directive is ours as well. We are encouraged to ask if God's words that are spoken on our lips are carried out with our hands.

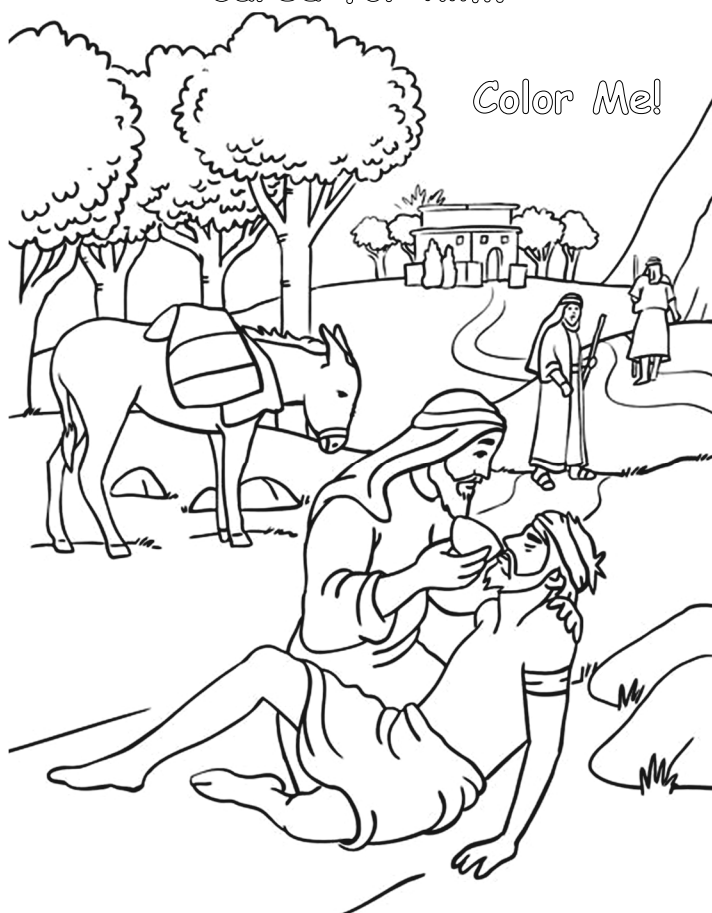

Be constantly vigilant anytime your children are near water

Reflexión Semanal

Buscando el corazón samaritano

Las lecturas y oraciones de hoy nos desafían a que las palabras que proclamamos se conviertan en acciones para nuestra vida. En el Evangelio, un erudito de la ley identifica los dos grandes mandamientos como el medio para obtener la vida eterna. Jesús reafirma sus palabras y le dice: "Haz esto y vivirás". Cuando el erudito presiona a Jesús para que defina la palabra "prójimo", Jesús cuenta la historia de un viajero que fue "víctima de ladrones" y que fue despojado, golpeado y abandonado para morir. Su situación era "complicada"; una situación que ninguno de los tres viajeros: un sacerdote, un levita y un samaritano, habían anticipado encontrar. Tanto el sacerdote como el levita ven a la víctima, cruzan al otro lado del camino y apresurados siguen su rumbo. El samaritano, en lugar de ignorar al hombre herido, curó sus heridas, lo transportó y pagó para que lo cuidaran. Al terminar la parábola, Jesús le pregunta al erudito: "¿Cuál de estos tres fue el prójimo de la víctima de los ladrones?". Luego de que responde: "El que lo trató con misericordia", Jesús le dice: "Ve y haz lo mismo". Nosotros también debemos "ir y hacer lo mismo". En el Salmo responsorial proclamamos: "Tus palabras, Señor, son espíritu y vida" y si lo son, debemos asegurarnos de que se hagan realidad. Moisés habla sobre esto en la lectura del libro del Deuteronomio y les recuerda a los israelitas "Estos mandamientos que te doy, no son superiores a tus fuerzas ni están fuera de tu alcance . . . están muy a tu alcance, en tu boca y en tu corazón, para que puedas cumplirlos". Esta instrucción es también para nosotros y se nos anima a preguntar si las palabras de Dios que pronunciamos con los labios se llevan a cabo con nuestras manos.

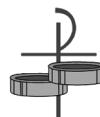
