From Our Pastor

Extraordinary Hospitality

One of the great gifts of our baptism is knowing that we belong. We belong first to our God, our creator, who gives us life in love, saved us through Jesus through love, and binds us together as His people with love. Being a beloved son or daughter of God is essential for us who seek to embrace and be embraced by God and others.

Sunday's readings speak of Abraham's and Sarah's generosity by entertaining three men who revealed God's presence. Martha and Mary reveal that true discipleship reflects hospitality.

This past week, a number of parishioners gathered to reflect on being a parish that offers 'Extraordinary Hospitality'. Our parish "Mission Statement" states we are a "Welcoming Community of Disciples of Jesus Christ." This desire is an ongoing challenge. Small faith sharing communities will be formed throughout the parish where all are welcome. This process along with all our ministries of service will call forth greater participation and leadership. What a great opportunity lies before us. May we pray that we will respond to the invitation that first comes from God so that we might share God's gifts in love, through love, and with love for one another.

Weekly Reflection

Ask, Knock, Seek

I suppose any one of us could find in our lives some example of one of the great, perplexing mysteries of Christianity, the mystery of unanswered prayer. Today's Gospel passage underlines that mystery. God likens Himself to a Father who cares for all of his children's needs. "Ask, and you will receive; seek, and you will find." The Gospel story seems to be saying that if we only keep at it, ask with persistence and trust, we shall surely receive what we need.

The key is to keep our prayer God-centered, to be aware of the way God chooses to act in our lives and in the world. And as God has told us so many times, God's way is not our way. When people and situations are difficult, we try to change them, and if we can't, we tend to project our way onto God and expect God to make these changes for us. But God will not do that.

That's not to say God doesn't answer our prayers and come to the aid of those in need – God most definitely does - but not by changing things outside of the one who prays, rather changing them from the inside. God does this through the gifts of understanding (coming to know God's purpose), perseverance (enduring all things for God's purpose), and charity (the ability to forgive, show mercy - to love as God loves).

All of these gifts, help to end suffering, not by changing what bothers me, but by changing me. This is the ongoing process of conversion, of being transformed more and more into faithful daughters and sons of our Father, the image of Jesus. Time and again in the Gospel God tells us where to look for God's presence. Jesus says, the Kingdom, the power and presence of God's love is within us. May we live more and more in the fullness of this Truth!





Vet your child's summer sleep-away camp

For many children, summer sleep-away camps are great adventures that become cherished memories. But for parents, the concern of sexual abuse is one that needs to be addressed. Before enrolling your child in a summer camp, consider staff reputation and screening practices. Ask questions about how the camp screens counselors and workers who will have access to your children (cafeteria workers, cooks, maintenance staff, etc.). Ask about any problems they may have handled previously, or how they would handle a complaint from a child. Get all the information you need to be comfortable before you send your child off for a few weeks of fun. Reflexión Semanal

Pidan, busquen, toquen

Supongo que cualquiera de nosotros podría encontrar en su vida algún ejemplo de uno de los más grandes y desconcertantes misterios del cristianismo: el misterio de la oración sin respuesta. El Evangelio nos habla de este misterio hoy. Dios se compara a sí mismo con un padre que cuida de todas las necesidades de sus hijos: "Pidan y se les dará, busquen y encontrarán, toquen y se les abrirá". La historia parece estar diciéndonos que si lo seguimos tratando, si preguntamos con persistencia y confianza, seguramente recibiremos lo que necesitamos.

La clave es mantener nuestra oración centrada en Dios, de esta manera podemos apreciar la manera con la cual Dios quiere actuar en nuestras vidas y en el mundo. Dios nos ha dicho muchas veces que nuestro camino no es su camino, pero insistimos en hacer cambios cuando las personas o las situaciones se ponen difíciles. Al no poder cambiarlas, proyectamos nuestro camino en Dios y esperamos que Él haga los cambios por nosotros. Sin embargo, Dios no lo hará.

Esto no significa que Dios no responde a nuestras oraciones o no viene a ayudar a quienes lo necesitan – Dios definitivamente lo hace – pero no lo hará cambiando lo que está afuera de la persona que ora, sino cambiando lo que está adentro de la persona que ora. Dios nos responde a través de los dones del entendimiento (para conocer el propósito de Dios), la perseverancia (para resistir todo de acuerdo al propósito de Dios) y la caridad (para perdonar, ser misericordiosos y amar como Dios ama).

Todos estos dones ayudan a terminar con el sufrimiento, no cambiando lo que me molesta, sino cambiándome a mí. Este es el proceso continuo de la conversión, de ser transformados cada vez más en las hijas e hijos fieles de nuestro Padre, la imagen de Jesús. En el Evangelio Dios nos dice una y otra vez dónde buscar su presencia. Jesús dice que el Reino, el poder y la presencia del amor de Dios está dentro de nosotros. ¡Vivamos cada vez más en la plenitud de esta verdad!
