





#### WEEKLY REFLECTION

Under Roman rule, the Jews paid a religious tax to the Jewish authorities for the maintenance of the temple as well as a tax to the Roman government. The Roman tax included both income taxes and duties in the form of tolls to use roads, bridges and to enter towns. The Roman taxes were collected by a class of independent contractors, usually Jews. The tax collectors paid a fixed sum for the right to collect. Anything they could collect above what they paid for the franchise was profit. Tax collectors were an ever-present symbol of Roman oppression. Often, they used cruel methods to become wealthy at the expense of their countrymen. Jewish society treated tax-collectors as the lowest class of sinners. Regarded as traitors, they were rejected socially and politically.

Pharisees were strict legalists, standing for rigid observance of Jewish law and tradition. They sought to impose that rigidity on the people. Though honored by Jewish society, Jesus saw them as covetous, self-righteous and hypocritical.

Here, both stand before God. The tax collector, free from pride or arrogance humbles himself because he knows himself to be a sinner and asks for God's mercy. The Pharisee praises himself because he is clueless that he too is a sinner.

God asks that we honestly look at ourselves and how our words and actions impact others. I ask myself: do I truly consider what I do and what I fail to do? Did I miss an opportunity for compassion and helpfulness? Did I miss a chance to act as Jesus would? Have I reached out to the socially and politically rejected? No matter who you are, no one is beyond the scope of God's mercy. I have to understand that I need his mercy and need to ask for it.





#### REFLEXIÓN SEMANAL

Bajo el dominio romano, los judíos pagaban un impuesto religioso a las autoridades judías para el mantenimiento del templo, así como un impuesto al gobierno romano. El impuesto romano induía tanto los impuestos sobre la renta como los aranceles en forma de peajes para usar carreteras, puentes y para ingresar a las ciudades. Los impuestos romanos eran recaudados por una dase de contratistas independientes, generalmente judíos, que pagaban una suma fija por el derecho a cobrar. Cualquier cosa que pudieran recaudar por encima de lo que pagaban por la franquicia, era ganancia. Los recaudadores de impuestos eran un símbolo siempre presente de la opresión romana y a menudo utilizaban métodos crueles para hacerse ricos a expensas de sus paisanos. La sociedad judía trataba a los recaudadores de impuestos como la dase más baja de pecadores y como se consideraban traidores, eran rechazados social y políticamente.

Los fariseos eran estrictos legalistas que defendían la rígida observancia de la ley y la tradición judías. Ellos pretendían imponer esa misma rigidez a la gente. Aún siendo honrados por la sociedad judía, Jesús los vio como codiciosos, mojigatos e hipócritas.

Aquí, ambos están ante Dios. Por un lado, el recaudador de impuestos, libre de orgullo o arrogancia, se humilla porque sabe que es un pecador y pide la misericordia de Dios. Por otro lado, el fariseo se alaba a sí mismo porque no tiene idea de que él también es un pecador.

Dios nos pide que honestamente nos miremos a nosotros mismos y a cómo nuestras palabras y acciones tienen un impacto en los demás. Me pregunto si ¿yo realmente considero lo que hago y lo que dejo de hacer? ¿Perdí una oportunidad para ser compasivo y ayudar? ¿Perdí la oportunidad de actuar como lo haría Jesús? ¿Me he acercado a los que son rechazados social y políticamente? Sin importar quién seas, nadie está más allá del alcance de la misericordia de Dios. Tengo que entender que necesito de su misericordia y que necesito pedirla.



#### **Your Offerings At Work**

#### Income

Our Lady of the Assumption relies on your donations. Thank you for your support. Regular envelope and holy day giving for this last fiscal year totaled about \$1.2 million which is slightly down from the year before. Many factors contributed to the decrease in weekly envelope collections, the most prominent being the Called to Renew campaign and a decline in church attendance. This source of income essentially covers the ongoing operating expenses (see below). Special restricted donations totaled \$760 thousand. All totaled, including revenues charged for programs the revenues of the parish totaled just over \$2 million for the church and \$1.8 million for the school.

#### **Operating Expenses**

Our parish expenses went up last year. These largely consist of Salaries/ Benefits (\$844 thousand) and Operating Costs (\$604 thousand) which include utilities, insurances, liturgy expenses, repairs and maintenance etc. The Ministry and Education costs were down and totaled \$214 thousand this year. Education costs this year also included \$40 thousand for school subsidy. Our Lady of the Assumption keeps 90% of general donations and 100% of building fund and other restricted donations. These are used for renovation, upkeep, repairs, and improvements of our aging facilities, education and social services. Our assessment paid to the Archdiocese this year was \$135 thousand. All totaled, Our Lady of the Assumption's operating expenses were \$1.8 million. Adding in the completed capital improvements this year, we had a net decrease of \$57 thousand in our reserves.
