FROM OUR PASTOR

Days of Remembrance

We have just completed the great fall

triduum of the Eve of All Hallows, All Saint's Day, and All Souls Day. It is easy to miss their significance since we often allow secular observances to cloud its meaning. During the Fall, the earth prepares for winter. This signals a period of dying, of dormancy and hibernation. This weekend also marks the end of daylight savings time as we "fall back" into the early hours of darkness. This is a time for Christians to reflect on the reality of dying and rising with the Lord.

By reclaiming our Christian traditions, we affirm our Christian discipleship

and seek lives of holiness. During the Easter Triduum: Holy Thursday, Good Friday, and Holy Saturday, we recall the ultimate gift of salvation through Christ's Passion, Death, and Resurrection. During these days, we remember the graces of Easter lived by the saints and martyrs whose lives reveal the saving work of Christ's transforming love in their lives. On Halloween, it was the tradition of dressing up and acting like the saints of old. Celebrations of Mass and festivals followed on All Saint's Day honoring our patron saints. We rejoice that God worked in their lives in hope and trust that we share a similar destiny in heaven.

On All Souls Day, we commemorate all our faithful departed. In our Catholic tradition, we remember "the souls in purgatory, waiting for eternal happiness and for meeting the Beloved is a source of suffering, because of the

punishment due to sin which separates them from God. But there is also the certitude that once the time of purification is over, the soul will get to meet the One it desires." (Letter of Pope St. John Paul II of Millennium of All Soul's Day).

Since the earliest experiences of the Church, we pray with the saints and for the dead as we offer masses for their intentions. We visit family graves and recall the love and mercy that is shared. In Mexico, on el Dia de los Muertos (Day of the Dead), people take picnics to their family graves and leave food out for their dead relatives. During this triduum of days, we must not forget our intimate union with the Lord and with those who have gone before us marked with the "Sign of Faith," the Communion of Saints.

WEEKLY REFLECTION

Today's readings and prayers remind us of God's continuous interaction with his creation. God loves his creation and is constantly calling it to holiness. God loved the world so much that he sent Jesus to save the world from sin. Many who lived during Jesus' lifetime received personal invitations to repent. Zacchaeus in Luke's gospel was one of those Jesus personally called to conversion. When Jesus summons Zacchaeus down from the sycamore tree and invites himself to stay at the tax collector's house, Zacchaeus is transformed and "received Jesus with joy." His life is forever changed as

Jesus says, "Today salvation has come to this house because this man too is a descendant of Abraham." Jesus' time on earth was temporary but on Pentecost the Holy Spirit descended upon the earth and has been our guide and inspiration ever since. Saint Paul reminds us of this in his letter to the Thessalonians where he prays for the community, asking that "our God may make you worthy of his calling and powerfully bring to fulfillment every good purpose and every effort of faith...." These words give us great comfort because they reinforce the words from Responsorial Psalm, "The Lord is faithful in all his words and holy in all his works. The Lord lifts up all who are falling and raises up all who are bowed down." Knowing that God is watching over us every moment of our lives gives us the courage to face each day, regardless of its challenge. We joyfully proclaim, Lord, "everyday will I bless you, and I will praise your name forever and ever."





INDEPENDENT COMPENSATION PROGRAM FOR VICTIM-SURVIVORS OF ABUSE BY DIOCESAN CLERGY (ICP)

As part of our long-standing commitment to provide pastoral care and to support

the healing process for victim-survivors, the Archdiocese of Los Angeles, along with five other dioceses in California, is participating in the new Independent Compensation Program by the Archdiocese of Los Angeles, Diocese of Fresno, Diocese of Orange, Diocese of Sacramento, Diocese of San Bernardino, and Diocese of San Diego for Victim-Survivors of Sexual Abuse of Minors by Priests (ICP). The ICP is administered independently of the Church by Kenneth Feinberg and Camille Biros, widely recognized as premier dispute resolution administrators in the country. The program is now accepting registrations from any person who has been sexually abused as a minor by diocesan priests of the participating dioceses, no matter when that abuse might have occurred. Funding

for the program in our Archdiocese will come from self-insured reserves, monies set aside for this purpose. We pray that this new program might provide another avenue toward healing



DIOS CUMPLE

Su vida cambia por completo, como dice Jesús: "Hoy ha llegado la salvación a esta casa, porque este hombre también es hijo de Abraham".


