WEEKLY REFLECTION WAITING

Last week we marked the end of the liturgical cycle with the celebration of the Feast of Christ the King. Today we begin anew with the First Sunday of Advent. The season of Advent reminds us that life is about waiting. When we think of our daily routines, we realize that we spend a great deal of our time waiting; standing in line at the grocery store, holding for a phone conversation, or sitting in the doctor's office. Waiting can be difficult and stressful. Yet, when we anticipate waiting and prepare for it, we can be more at peace. During the day, if we anticipate that we might have to wait, we can come



prepared with a book to read, a list to make, a letter to write, or prayers to say. So it is with the message from today's readings. Advent reminds us that we are waiting for Jesus to come again and if we prepare ourselves spiritually, the waiting is less foreboding. Saint Paul tells us that now is the time to "put on the armor of light" by "conducting ourselves properly" as we anticipate and prepare for Jesus' coming. Matthew encourages us to "Stay awake!" He reminds us that we can become complacent in our daily routines and be caught off guard. So, Advent is our wake up call! And even though the waiting is difficult and we are restless, we come together as community in joyful support of one another. As we share the Holy Eucharist, we are affirmed in Jesus' promise that He will return to take each one of us to our heavenly home.
