The Ten Commandments

THE TEN

- 1. I AM THE LORD YOUR GOD. YOU SHALL WORSHIP THE LORD YOUR GOD AND HIM ONLY SHALL YOU SERVE.
- 2. YOU SHALL NOT TAKE THE NAME OF THE LORD YOUR GOD IN VAIN.
- 3. REMEMBER TO KEEP HOLY THE SABBATH DAY.
- 4. HONOR YOUR FATHER AND YOUR MOTHER.
- 5. YOU SHALL NOT KILL.

COMMANDMENTS

- 6. YOU SHALL NOT COMMIT ADULTERY.
- 7. YOU SHALL NOT STEAL.
- 8. YOU SHALL NOT BEAR FALSE WITNESS.
- 9. YOU SHALL NOT COVET YOUR NEIGHBOR'S WIFE.
- 10. YOU SHALL NOT COVET YOUR NEIGHBOR'S GOODS.



Gospel of St. Matthew 5:3-10



Q. What is Virtue?



The opposite... is VICE

Patterns of behavior that are harmful to one's self or others, character weaknesses – essentially **bad habits**

So then VIRTUE is:

Good habits – character strengths manifested on a consistent basis in decision making.

Our Upbringing is Important!



Missing the Mark

The root word for Sin means "Off Center"



Another definition for sin:

"Hardness of the Heart"

Failure to be human...

Owning of our SIN

If we deny the presence of sin in our lives then we deny our own responsibility for our actions.

Original Sin -The sin owned by all
