# Four Steps of RCIA

---

## Inquiry & Evangelization:

Hearing & responding to God's call.  
Concludes with the Rite of Acceptance.

## Catechumenate:

Knowing & experiencing the faith (Scripture, Prayer, beliefs, and values). Concludes with the Rite of Election.

## Purification & Enlightenment:

Elect scrutinize their openness to grace - receive sacraments of initiation at the Easter Vigil Mass.

---


- **Neophytes continue to meet until Pentecost, and become more involved in the Church community. It's a time for:**
