Our goal is to teach and/or improve social, behavioral, communication and academic skills for children with Autism and Asperger Syndrome. We are in need of an **Intervention Specialist** for the 2018-2019 school year.

The job of the IS would be to administer specific interventions, modifications, and accommodations to our students with Autism in Preschool through 8<sup>th</sup> grade, as well as assisting the child's assign district and families in writing their IEP. The IS would also be working closely with the child's aide and teacher(s) to help with modifications/accommodations for the child to be successful in the regular educational setting.

We currently have a staff of 5 aides, 1 Speech/Language Pathologist, 1 Occupational Therapist, 1 Music Therapist, and 1 Behavior Modification Therapist, as well as our school nurse that we work closely with.
