Mrs. Colette Clayton - 7th & 8th Grade

It's hard to believe we are already making our way to the last week of September! The 7th and 8th grade reading classes have been enjoying the novel A Long Walk to Water by Linda Sue Parks. It is a dual narrative that follows two young people on their journey of survival across the Southern Sudan weaved together with the common need for clean water. We are mastering skills of close reading while comparing history to fiction. Last week we were blessed to welcome a guest speaker the Dunlap family brought to speak to the 6th, 7th and 8th graders about real life survival of the for clean water of a mother and her daughter who live between Zambia and Centerville. It was a incredible tie-in to our novel to meet and learn how Heather and her daughter, Radius, are helping to drill wells in villages to bring clean water to many families.

The 8th graders have already taken their first writing piece through to publication. Their Important Piece was written in third person and shared insight into the personal lives of each 8th grader and what each one values. They have worked hard on their editing skills! Looking ahead, the 8th grade will be very busy in October as we head out to visit three of our area Catholic High Schools; Alter, Carroll, and Chaminade Julienne. These are always favorite days for the students where they not only explore the high school campuses, visit classrooms, but they also have an opportunity to see past STAG graduates.

PTO Restaurant Night - Sunday, October 7th






