Happy New Year from 4th Grade!

I have been so blessed to have been given this amazing group of students two years in a row. Having moved from 3rd to 4th grade, all of us had to adjust to the demands the 4th grade curriculum requires. We did it with courage, patience, and a sense of humor.

We teach Math, Science and Religion to 27 4th Graders. We have spent considerable time learning 3-digit multiplication and long division.
