Tardies

Parents and Guardians we are having trouble with tardies at St. Albert the Great School. On average we have about 20 students tardy each day. It is important to get your children to school on time. Our first bell rings at 7:40am and last bell is 7:50am. When students arrive late they are missing out on instructional time and the morning routine of getting ready for the school day. House Bill 410 defines Excessive absence as absent 38 or more hours in on school month or 65 mor more hours in a school year with or without a legitimate excuse. The minutes or hours a child misses for tardies adds into these numbers. Please plan according to the distance from your house to the school. We understand that accidents happen on the road, or the unplanned flat tire, but constantly getting to school on time is important to your child's success in school.
