#### Dear Families and Friends of St. Mark's,

With all the confusion of the social and political upheavals in the past year, many have seriously wondered if it is the end of the world, or at least the beginning of the end. In faith, we Christians are always preparing for the "end" at the time of our death and/or the Second Coming of Christ in glory, whichever comes first. We desire to participate in the "First Resurrection", that is, our own conversion so to avoid the "Second Death" in judgment. But nowadays, admittedly, the "end" is on the minds of many, even more than in past years.


As we enter the Holy Season of Advent on this first Sunday of Advent—once again, but in 2023—God's Word reminds us that we should be well prepared and always ready to meet Jesus at all times, either at the end of our lives or at the end of the world, whichever comes first, but without worry. We are invited to meditate on Jesus' first coming in history as a baby in Bethlehem, his daily coming into our lives in mystery through the Sacraments and Sacred Scripture, and finally his *Second Coming* at the end of the world to reward the just and punish the wicked.

The traditional signs of Advent in our Church remind us that just as Jesus is coming to us, we must prepare ourselves to come to Him. Saint Paul exhorts the early Christian communities and the Church's faithful in every age to be ready to meet Jesus by discharging their duties properly and by freeing themselves from their former pagan tendencies. In the Gospels, Jesus warns us of the urgency of vigilant preparation, recalling, for example, how the unrepentant and ill-prepared were caught unawares by Noah's flood and how a thief can plunder the precious belongings of an unprepared house owner. As we prepare for a joyful Christmas—despite a chaotic modern world—the Church gently reminds us once again to "stay alert", by prayer, works of charity, by self-control in resisting our evil inclinations, and by seeking reconciliation with God and our fellow human beings. Thus will we be well prepared for Jesus' rebirth in our hearts, our families, our world this Christmas.




