PRESCHOOL TUITION & FEES:

Full Day Schedule

5 days: Monday - Friday (8:00 a.m3:00 p.m.)	\$675/mo.
4 days: Choose days (8:00 a.m3:00 p.m.)	\$550/mo.
3 days: Choose days (8:00 a.m3:00 p.m.)	\$435/mo.
2 days: Choose days (8:00 a.m3:00 p.m.)	\$310/mo.

Half Day

5 days: Monday - Friday (8:00 a.m12:00 p.m.)	\$435/mo.
4 days: choose days (8:00 a.m12:00 p.m.)	\$355/mo.
3 days: choose days (8:00 a.m12:00 p.m.)	\$265/mo.
2 days: choose days (8:00 a.m12:00 p.m.)	\$190/mo.

Before Care (7:30-8:00 a.m.) Drop off as early as 7:30 a.m.

After Care (3:00-5:30 p.m.)

5 days—\$275/mo.

4 days—\$220/mo.

3 days—\$165/mo.

2 days—\$110/mo.

1 day-\$55/mo.

REGISTRATION FEE:

Upon acceptance into Preschool, a Registration Fee of \$360, will be due.

FEES IN ADDITION TO TUITION:

· A \$75 class fee will be charged for supplies for centers, field trips and other projects (payable the 1st day of school)

OTHER INFORMATION:

- The student uniform will consist of Navy pants and shorts and a Red polo shirt. Girls may also wear a navy jumper, skirt or skort (see pictures for style of jumper, skirt and skort)
- · Hot lunch can be ordered or students may a sack lunch daily. Snacks are also encouraged for recess
- · Students will have Individual Photos taken in the Fall and a Class Photo taken in the Spring
- · Safe Environment Workshop Background Check (needed to volunteer**) \$13 and up per adult

**EACH Volunteer (classroom helpers, etc.) must complete the Diocesan sponsored Safe Environment Workshop and pay the billed Background Check fee.

VOLUNTEER HOURS:

Not required for preschool families

CHILDREN MUST BE FULLY POTTY TRAINED, BEFORE BEING ADMITTED TO St. Mark's Preschool.

Fully potty trained means that the child independently asks to go to the bathroom when needed and is able to wipe themselves, flush, and wash their hands. St. Mark's School understands that occasionally, even the fully potty trained child will have an accident. We ask that parents provide a complete change of clothing in a child's backpack for these occasions.
