St. Mark's Catholic School Uniform Policy

Guide for Students and Parents

SHIRTS



All shirts should fit properly and be tucked in at all times

Grades PreK & K Red — polo , turtleneck, or mock turtleneck. No Label or Logo

Grades 1–5 White -polo, turtleneck, or mock turtleneck. No Label or Logo

Grades 6-8 White, navy or Columbia blue polo shirt with "Saint Mark's School" logo embroidered. *

JUMPERS & SKIRTS

No shorter than 3" above the knee

Grades PreK & K Navy



Grades 1-5 Dunbar Plaid *

Grades 6-8 Navy blue or Khaki twill pleated.

SOLID White, black, gray or navy blue leggings are only allowed under a jumper or skirt

SHORTS & PANTS

Classic uniform style dress pants - twill or corduroy.

Grades PreK-5 Navy blue

Grades 6-8 Navy blue or khaki. Solid black, brown, tan or navy blue belt.

Shorts – must be 3" above the knee

OUTERWEAR



Must have collared uniform shirt underneath.

Sweatshirts St. Mark's navy or Columbia blue sweatshirts, crew, hoodie or 1/4 zip

Vests & Cardigans Navy blue or red, zipper or button up. Full Zip Jacket Navy blue with school logo.

Uniform, hooded sweatshirts may NOT be worn at Student Body Masses

MASS DRESS



Required every Wednesday for Mass

Boys A clean, white, button down dress shirt. Tie – school plaid* or navy. Uniform pants.

Girls A clean, white, button down blouse. Jumper, skirt or uniform pants.

Shorts and hoodies are never allowed at Student Body Mass

FOOTWEAR



Athletic shoes must be solid white, navy, brown, gray or black. Only logo may be different color.



Dress shoes & boots white, navy, brown, gray, or black. low heels with enclosure or backstrap



Socks & Tights SOLID White, black, gray or navy blue

Flip-flops, sandals, cowboy boots, slippers and cleats are considered unsafe and are not acceptable

SPIRIT DAYS





Jeans or solid colored shorts. St. Mark's spirit T-shirt and/or St. Mark's sweatshirt

Jeggings, leggings, yoga pants, sweatpants, athletic pants, and athletic shorts are not allowed

FREE DRESS DAYS

Students may choose their outfit as long as it follows the Overall Student Appearance Guidelines

Free Dress Passes must be used on Fridays only.
Other free dress days will be announced in Friday Facts or by classroom teacher.

Jeggings, leggings, yoga pants, sweatpants, athletic pants, and athletic shorts are not allowed

Overall Student Appearance Guidelines

Good personal hygiene must be practiced daily.

CLOTHING

Clean, pressed and free of rips or holes

Pants

- Jeggings and yoga pants are not allowed
- Sweatpants, athletic pants, and athletic shorts are not allowed

Tops

• Tank, sleeveless, cami tops, and tshirts with offensive graphics are never allowed

Outerwear

All non-uniform outerwear is only to be worn outside of the building

Accessories

 Hats, caps, bandanas, and scarves are not to be worn inside the building

Winter Uniform

Thanksgiving to Spring Break

- no shorts
- skirts and jumpers must be worn with tights, leggings or knee-highs



HAIR

Clean, neat, trimmed, kept out of face

- No artificial hair coloring
- No extreme haircuts ex. mullets, mohawks, etc
- No wraps or beading
- Bows & Accessories Navy, white or school plaid
- Boys above ear, off the collar, no facial hair

- Minimal makeup for 7th & 8th grade girls only
- Modestly painted fingernails for girls only
- No artificial nails

JEWELRY

- One religious bracelet and/or necklace
- One ring on each hand allowed
- One single stud in the earlobe allowed for girls only
- No cartilage piercings allowedBody piercings and tattoos are not allowed

Under all instances, interpretation of the Uniform Dress Code is at the discretion of the Principal.
