Feb. 2/3 EM Marked in Yellow do Blessing of St. Blaise Only - Not Communion

Blessing of St. Blaise - Feb. 2 and 3

1. If you are scheduled to serve on February 2 and 3, please arrive 20 minutes before Mass. The EM should put on robes and sit together during Mass in the front pew(s) on the west side of the Church.
2. The Blessing will be given at the end of the Homily by the Celebrant and the EM.
3. The consecrated candles with a red ribbon tied around them plus cards with the Blessing printed on them will be located just in front of the baptismal font on the west side of the Sanctuary. The Priest will come to the edge of the Sanctuary and bless the first EM and then ask that EM to bless him. After being blessed, the EM should get a candle from the table by the Baptismal Font and bless another EM (until all EM have been blessed) and then Celebrant and EM should go to the positions shown below.
4. A small card with the blessing printed on it will be available for you to hold in your hand during the Blessing. The candles should be placed near the throat as shown in the picture on next page and the following blessing given by the Celebrant or the EM:

“Through the intercession of St. Blaise, bishop and martyr, may God deliver you from ailments of the throat and from every other evil. In the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Spirit. Amen.”

Please note that the Celebrant will give the sign of the Cross after his blessing – the EM should not make the sign of the cross.



5. After the Blessing, the EM who will serve Communion should return candles to the baskets by the Baptismal Font and return to the pew on the west side until time for Lord’s Prayer. We will not be doing the Precious Blood for Communion.
6. The EM at each Mass that will not serve Communion (names marked on the schedule in Yellow) can remove their robes and return to their seats when finished.
7. The EM serving Communion should go to the back of the Church at the Lord’s Prayer and then file out as normal for Communion.
