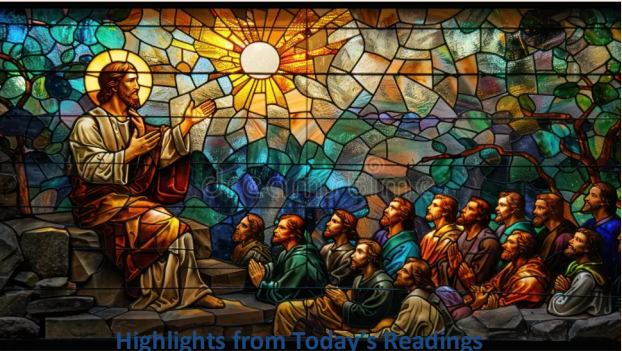

Highlights from Today's Readings

First Reading (Zephaniah 2:3; 3:12-13): The prophet Zephaniah calls the humble and lowly to seek the Lord, encouraging righteousness and humility. God promises to leave a remnant—"a people humble and lowly"—who will take refuge in Him and do no wrong. The reading highlights that God values humility and faithfulness over pride and self-sufficiency.

Responsorial Psalm (Psalm 146): The psalmist praises God, who "keeps faith forever," lifts up the lowly, and protects the oppressed, the hungry, the blind, and the stranger. The Psalm echoes the theme of God’s special care for the poor and vulnerable.

Second Reading (1 Corinthians 1:26-31): St. Paul reminds the Corinthians that God often chooses the weak and lowly in the world to reveal His power and wisdom. Boasting is excluded; all should glory only in the Lord. The reading challenges us to embrace humility and recognize God’s grace as the source of all good.

Gospel (Matthew 5:1-12a – The Beatitudes): Jesus proclaims the Beatitudes, blessing those who are poor in spirit, meek, merciful, peacemakers, and persecuted for righteousness. He reveals that true happiness lies in living according to God’s vision, not the world’s standards.
