

### The Lost Boys and Girls of Sudan Give Back

The Lost Boys and Girls of Sudan began their journey in 1987 when their villages were attacked by the Khartoum Government. By the year 2000, 3800 Lost Boys and Girls began the formal process of resettlement in the United States. Approximately one hundred Lost Boys currently reside in San Diego, California.

With the guidance of Bishop Dolan, The Corporal Works of Mercy has been helping the SD Lost Boys and Girls with their education, medical, dental and mental health expenses. The Lost Boys feel so blessed that they are now giving back to those left behind by raising funds for the Awoda School in Sudan.
