Saturdays at 5:30 p.m. on BOTH the HFC west patio and the School South Campus Courtyard

Sundays at 7:15, 9:00, 10:45 a.m. and 12:30 p.m. on the Holy Family Center west patio

Sundays 5:30 p.m. on BOTH the west patio of the HFC and the School South Campus Courtyard

## RESERVATIONS NO LONGER REQUIRED FOR ANY MASSES

#### **OTHER PRECAUTIONS**

- Chairs will be disinfected between Masses
- Communion is to be received in the hand only
- No communion cups of Precious Blood
- Eucharistic Ministers will sanitize their hands immediately prior to distribution of communion
- No holding hands at the Our Father
- No Sign of Peace
- One offertory basket will be placed at the entrance to drop your offering
- The congregation is asked not to sing to prevent more breath from circulating in the air

Held outside on the church patio;
face masks and social distancing protocol required

#### **CHURCH HOURS**

The Church building is closed until further notice

## **ALL GROUPS STILL SUSPENDED**

Regular meetings of parish groups and ministries are still suspended; groups will be notified when they can resume meeting

## **ONLINE MASS IS STILL OFFERED**

### **OUR MASS PROTOCOLS**

- Temperatures will be taken at the entrance, anyone with a temp of 100.4°F or higher is not permitted to enter
- Face masks must be worn at all times by ages 2+
- Bring your own hand sanitizer

(no hand sanitizer stations available outside)

- Social distancing of at least six feet must be maintained at all times
- Ushers will take parishioners to their seats
- We recommend bringing a hat, sunscreen, and a bottle of water, as you may end up in the sun
- Seating is first come, first served, ushers will take attendees to their seats
- Communion is distributed at the end of Mass

### **PLEASE BE PATIENT!**

- Our best chance for success is if we all partner to be patient, cooperative, and respect the guidelines set forth by the State
- This is an unprecedented situation and there will be a learning curve for everyone as we adjust to this new normal and plans continue to change on an ongoing basis
