

## Window #12 - CHRIST



### Left Side:

***Pax*** - Latin word for peace, symbolic of the peace we achieve through Christ.

***Serpent on Tau Cross*** - This refers to the passage, "Just as Moses lifted up the serpent in the desert, so must the Son of Man be lifted up." (John 3:14)

***Pelican*** - a pelican, feeding its young from the blood of its own breast, is a story often told that the pelican tears open its own breast to feed her young in time of famine. So Christ shed His blood for man.

### Right Side:

***Crown of Thorns with Three Nails*** - symbolizes the crucifixion of Christ.

***I.N.R.I.*** - This is an abbreviation rather than a monogram. The letters are the first letters of the Latin phrase, *Iesus Nazarenus Rex Iudaeorum*, which means, "Jesus the Nazarene The King of the Jews." (John 19:19)
