As part of its task, this commission oversees the education, training and scheduling of all Liturgical Ministers, including those who participate in the Art & Environment Team.

Liturgical ministries in our parish continue to grow as more and more parishioners are being trained to participate as liturgical ministers. We continue to utilize the Ministry Scheduler Pro online program designed to 14

streamline the scheduling of our ministries. We have seen tremendous growth in the development of our youth choirs and cantors.

Needed are dedicated persons who minister the Body and Blood of Jesus to parishioners during Mass. This is a commissioned ministry for fully initiated Catholics (Confirmed). Ministers are trained and scheduled.
- Nursing Home/Homebound Ministry Distribution of Holy Communion to shut-in parishioners, to residents at Azalea Hills retirement community, and other Nursing Home facilities. This is a very special ministry that touches the lives of those unable to attend Mass, reminding them that they are still a vital part of our faith community. Training is provided.
- Lector Proclaimers of the Word of God! From the mouth of the proclaimer to the ears of the hearers, the Word of God comes alive.
 Adults and youth with a love of Holy Scripture, with good voice quality, who enunciate clearly and read with understanding are invited to participate in proclaiming the Word of God at Mass. Training is provided.

- Gift Bearer Families / individuals to present the gifts of bread and wine during Mass. Since the early days of the Church the bread and wine needed for consecration have been brought forth from the community. Today, as these gifts pass us in procession we are invited to symbolically place ourselves within the bowl on the altar to be transformed and become Christ for the world.

MUSIC MINISTRIES

- Instrumentalist Organ/piano artists, guitarists, and various instrumentalists serve the parish and enhance the Liturgy by sharing their God-given talents with the faith community.
- Cantor Leader of sung prayer. Vocalists with pleasant voices and a love for Scripture will be trained to lead the sung prayer of our faith community. Cantors serve in a primary role at each of the weekend Masses. Junior Cantors are trained and begin serving as cantor at weekend Masses as young as the 6th grade.
- Choirs: Adult, Teen, Music Makers, Children, Cherub Do you sing in the shower or along with the radio? Consider lending your voice to a choir. There is great fun and satisfaction in being part of a group whose primary purpose is to touch the heart of God and His people through song. - Handbell Choir Ringers have a special touch! St. Mary of the Knobs is blessed to have a four octave set of handbells. Rhythm and desire will land you a place at the table in the Handbell Choir. 
