



# WOMEN'S BOOK STUDY



Women of the Parish are invited to read and discuss the book Jesus and the Jewish Roots of Mary by Brant Pitre beginning April 26th and ending in July. The group will usually meet on the 2nd & 4th Fridays, 11am until noon. Generally, a chapter of the book will be discussed at each session and questions to consider will be provided in advance for discussion as a group.

Jesus and the Jewish Roots of Mary is an eight-chapter book, 193 pages long. Through this book, we will learn about Scripture and its context as well as the viewpoints of ancient Christians that shaped the traditions that we have today. In the book, Dr. Pitre takes readers step-by-step from the Garden of Eden to the Book of Revelation to reveal how deep biblical Catholic beliefs about Mary really are. Dr. Pitre uses the Old Testament and Ancient Judaism to unlock how the Bible itself teaches that Mary is in fact the new Eve, the Mother of God, the Queen of Heaven and Earth, and the new Ark of the Covenant."
