

Do you know of a parishioner that is in the hospital, a care facility or homebound?

We often do not know when someone is in the hospital or that they are in a nursing home or assisted living facility unless the parishioner or a family member contacts us. The parish sick and homebound ministry visits those who are homebound or in a care facility and brings Holy Communion from Lay Ministers. It is important that you let us know where you are or that you would like us to visit you. Even if it is only temporary due to chemotherapy/medical treatments, rehabilitation, or if the need is long term, contact Beth to set up weekly visits from the parish.

Real people share their stories of what has helped them deal with the pain of losing a family member or friend through death. During the week between meetings, group members complete a daily Bible study and practical exercises to help them heal from grief. Like most organizations, the Raleigh Diocese has a retirement fund for priests who serve in our


