

**ASSUMPTION OF THE BVM CHURCH
ALTAR AND ROSARY SOCIETY MINUTES
AUGUST 17, 2021**

Treasurer's report was read by Debbie. The Starting Balance in the Checking Account was \$3,400.39, deposits totaled \$498.67 (Bake sale \$490.67 and dues \$8) and expenses were \$555.95: \$350 (Church cleaning) and \$205.95 (Gist card for Deacon Fred). The Ending Balance was \$3,343.11.

The Starting Balance in the Savings Account was \$2,286.09 and the Ending Balance remained \$2,286.21.

The Final Total of both accounts equaled \$5,629.32.
