

**ASSUMPTION OF THE BVM CHURCH  
ALTAR AND ROSARY SOCIETY MINUTES  
JUNE 15, 2021**

**Treasurer's report was read by Debbie. The Starting Balance in the Checking Account was \$3,270.39, deposits totaled \$480 (Bake sale) and expenses \$350 (Church cleaning). The Ending Balance was \$3,400.39.**

**The Starting Balance in the Savings Account was \$2,286.09 and the Ending Balance remained \$2,286.09.**

**The Final Total of both accounts equaled \$5,686.48.**

**Motion to accept the Treasurer's report was made by Sue and seconded by Gina.**

**Bake Sale: the bake sale was a success with a balance of \$480. Prewrapping and pricing of items worked out very well.**

**NEW BUSINESS:**

**The Basket Social is scheduled for the weekend of October 23 and 24, 2021. There are signs prepared for it; only the date needs to be changed. It will be advertised in the Church Bulletin, and other possible contacts will be notified by mail. The date has been cleared.**

**Elaine suggested that the charge for tickets be raised to \$6 or more. She also would like a space for a 'higher-priced item section.' She has numerous items with substantially higher value that she would like to donate. She also made a suggestion that several smaller boards be prepared for popular gift cards instead of putting them on one large board. This leads to the purchase of additional tickets.**

The calendar for the coming year will be announced in the near future.

There will be a bake sale on September 11 and 12, 2021.

A "Garage Sale" will be held in the Spring of 2022 possibly April 30<sup>th</sup>. It will be held in the parking lot where sections are already lined off. These spaces would be sold to sellers. Extra parking could be offered in the back of the Church for participants to park their own cars during the sale. Food may be offered if it is safe to do so. Bathrooms may be available if monitors are available.

The sale would start at approximately 9 a.m. and end by 4 p.m. All spaces and their contents would need to be cleared completely by 4 p.m. for Church parking.

A Nominating Committee consisting of Ruth, Sue, and Kathy D. was named by Elsie.

We will participate in the Walnutport Canal Day festival on Oct. 17, a Saturday. The rain date would be Oct. 18. Baked goods, which have been sealed and priced, will be needed.

Ruth will clarify the "coupon for soldiers" campaign next meeting.

Father Eric closed the meeting with the Hail Mary.

The meeting was adjourned by Elsie.
