Thank you very much for your faithful service to our parish family at SS Patrick & Andrew and All Saints. We are grateful for your generosity of spirit and sharing your time and talents with our parish families.

Our Mass schedule will be changing as of July 1, 2018, when our two formerly separate parishes will unify and become one parish with two sites: New Riegel and Bascom. The Mass schedule as of that time will be as follows:

Saturday: 5 pm at New Riegel

Sunday: 8 am at Bascom

Sunday: 10 am at New Riegel

As we move forward in faith, we want to truly live the first line of our parish mission statement: *we are a rural family of faith, welcoming all, for all belong!* No matter which Mass time and place you currently serve, we hope that you will continue to gather for worship and the sacraments with us. **We need your presence and we want you to share your gifts with our united parish family.** Over the last few years, we have begun to unify our practices for lectors, greeters/ushers, servers, and Extraordinary Ministers of Holy Communion, which should prove helpful in this transition process. However, we also want you to feel as comfortable as possible, especially if you will be ministering in a new space for the first time; therefore, a transition team is being formed to help you!

As you discern which Mass time and place may be the best fit for you, we invite you to share this decision with us so that we can begin making plans and schedules for the futures. A **response card** is enclosed to make sharing this information with us as easy as possible. The schedule for **daily Mass** will be changing on July 1, 2018 as well. If your schedule allows, we hope you will serve in ministries at daily Mass as well. All daily Masses will be held at the New Riegel campus with the Mass on Tuesdays at 5 p.m. and Masses on Wednesdays, Thursdays, and Fridays at 8 a.m. Please indicate your availability for serving at daily Mass on the response card as well.
