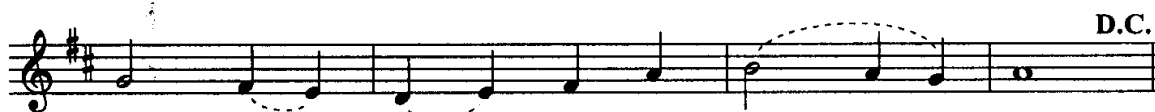




## Preface Dialogue
