**Plastic Bottled Goods** – Juice, Spaghetti Sauce, Jelly/Jam (especially Strawberry),  
Peanut Butter, Applesauce

**Dry Goods** – Cereal (especially kid favorites), Oatmeal, Granola Bars, Crackers,  
Mac & Cheese, Pasta, Rice, Instant Potatoes, Soup Mixes, Flour,  
Sugar, Brown Sugar, Powdered Sugar, Jello, Pudding

**Condiments** - Ketchup, Mustard, Pickle Relish, Mayo

**Personal Care items for the refugees** - Diapers, Baby Wipes, Baby Wash, Lotion,
