Okauchee Youth Baseball is again offering an opportunity for all area boys and girls to participate in our summer Baseball and Girls Fast Pitch Softball program. Last year, 450 Baseball and Softball Players from the Village of Okauchee, Town of Oconomowoc, and elsewhere participated in the program.

The program's goals are to educate players on Baseball and Fast Pitch Softball fundamentals, instill good sportsmanship, teach team play and to have fun. There are no team tryouts for grades 1 thru 6.

Every team member plays in every game. The batting lineup consists of all team members regardless of whether they are playing a defensive position. League rules also provide that every player must play a minimum of (3) innings of defense during each (6) inning game.

Depending upon the student's present grade in school, he/she will be placed on a team in a league consisting of only 1-2 graders, 3-4 graders, 5-6 graders or 7-8 graders.

Practices are during the Month of May.

Games are scheduled from beginning of June thru the First week of August.

Grades 1 thru 6 are provided team shirts, team caps and a baseball.
Grades 7 and 8 are provided Full Uniforms.

Okauchee baseball will again be selling candy bars for our fund raiser. Candy bars will be given out at registration. A check for \$52.00, which may be post dated to May 31, 2018 will be required to register. You may buy out of the fund raiser for \$26.00. No exceptions.
