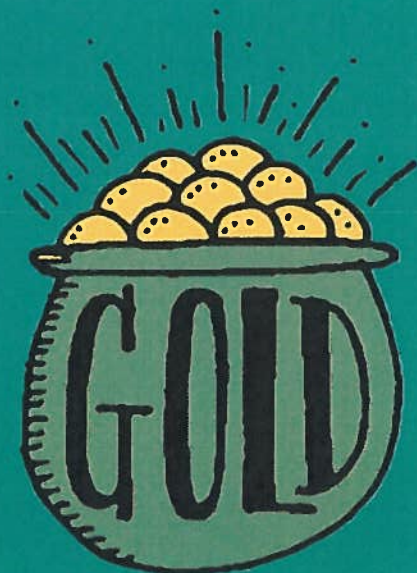

Poverty in Lake Country? Just ask the local food pantries. The St Vincent de Paul pantry in Hartland ran out of food the day before Thanksgiving 2017! The Oconomowoc pantry serves 200 families per month, and the Pewaukee pantry helps about 220. Pantry clients include families as well as the elderly.

Those living on the outskirts of poverty pass up the produce aisle. They don't understand the value of healthy food, and need to spend on the basics such as canned fruits, canned meats, canned vegetables and canned meals.

The joint Human Concerns Commission of St Joan of Arc and St Catherine of Alexandria, supported by the generosity of parishioners, answer the call of Pope Francis to "feed the hungry" The food ministry, started several years ago, supplies non-perishable food items as well as fresh produce through the "food Sunday" collections every second Sunday of the month. The Garden of Eat'n produces fresh organic produce delivered to local pantries during the growing season. To learn more about this ministry, or to help out contact Kathie at 262-313-8207.
