

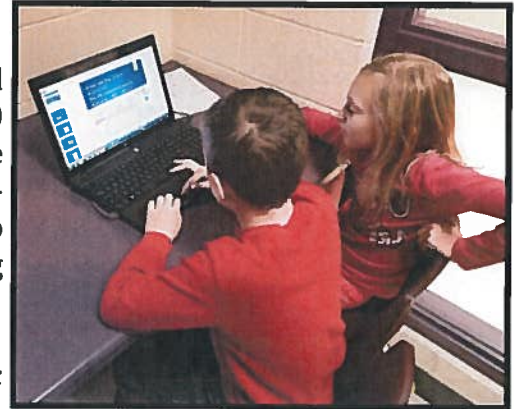

We have had an exciting couple of weeks at St. Joan of Arc Parish celebrating sacraments. The past two weekends, our St. Joan of Arc and St. Catherine of Alexandria 2nd graders were able to experience their First Reconciliation. If you are looking for an opportunity for reconciliation for yourself this Lenten season, Saturday we will celebrate Communal Reconciliation at St. Joan of Arc Parish at 10 a.m. As a reminder, we also have school liturgy this Friday at 8 a.m. and hope you can make it.

Next week at St. Joan of Arc Parish School, students in grades 3, 5, and 7, will be taking standardized testing. These tests include cognitive tests as well as skills assessments. The cognitive tests give us information about student learning styles and are used to predict how students are likely to perform on different skills assessments. The school then uses the data to determine how we can improve our instruction for the children in our classes. All schools in the Archdiocese of Milwaukee participate in standardized testing during the month of March.

Next week Friday, March 23, is the end of 3rd quarter. As such, we will have an early release day with 11:35 a.m. dismissal. After care will be available that afternoon. Please let Mrs. Andersen know by Monday if your child will be staying for after school care next Friday.
