# YOUTH PROGRAMS

**Our Youth Programs are based on Three Pillars rooted in our Catholic Education:  
Health and Fitness, Enrichment and Academics.**

**YAP (Youth Afterschool Program):** Monday through Thursday from 3 to 5 pm. our students grades 3 through 8 will have the opportunity to extend their day together with enriching activities lead by Mr. O two days and Mrs. Hernandez the other two! They will begin their time together with, **Movin' and Groovin'**. This will include a variety of gross motor opportunities such as hiking, basketball, volleyball, badminton, and bocce ball, to name only a few. Next, they will enjoy **Study and Snack**. Here they will have time for homework (assistance is offered if needed) and/or reading while enjoying a healthy snack. They will conclude their time together with **Life Skills**. These activities will include cooking, practical engineering and science exploration that connects to everyday living using our STEAM Lab, cooperative games and designing video games to name only a few! This program replaces the aftercare program for students in grades 3-8. Students that remain after 5 pm will join Mrs. Andersen for aftercare available until 6. Cost of this program will be \$10 for the 2 hour time period.

**M&M (Math Masters) Fridays from 3 to 4 pm.** – Youth in grades 3 through 8 are invited to team up with Mr. Gary Zwick in figuring out the Math Mystery of the day along with math homework assistance. Remember, everyone has mathematic skills and Mr. Zwick will help the children grow in mathematical confidence and begin to see themselves as true **Math Masters**. The cost for this program is \$5 per week.
