

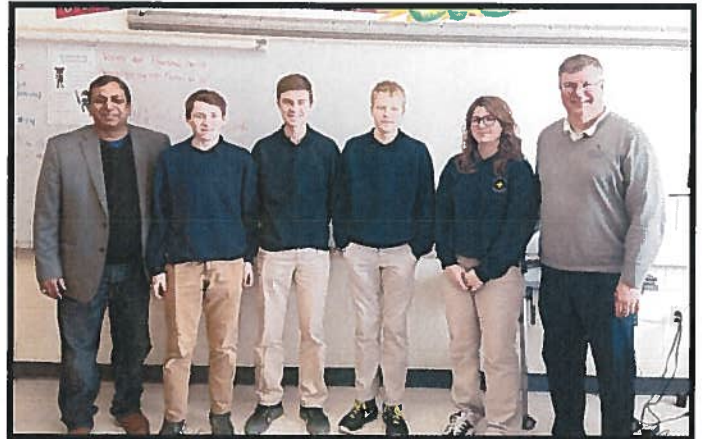

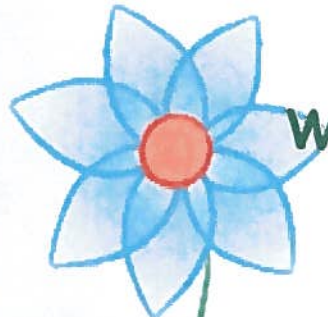

Thank you for volunteering for Vacation Bible School! As an adult or youth volunteer, you are a tremendous resource and we value your ministry to our children. Below are some guidelines to follow when volunteering with our young children. Please read these guidelines over and sign the bottom. Your signature indicates that you understand your responsibilities to the adult those you are working with and to the program.

My signature at the bottom of this agreement means that I am accepting the responsibility of helping to supervise children in the presence of adults. I understand that I am not a participant in this program, but an assistant who will work with children to enable them to enjoy Vacation Bible School. I am accepting this responsibility because I enjoy helping younger children to learn about God.

By signing this agreement, I am pledging my support to St. Joan of Arc and St. Catherine of Alexandria's Vacation Bible School (VBS) in the following ways:

1. I agree to assist the teachers and children as needed during VBS mornings
2. I agree to motivate, encourage, reassure and comfort the children whenever necessary.

(YOUTH) 3. I agree to stay with the teacher and his/her class at all times, unless it is necessary to perform other duties at the direction of the program director.

(YOUTH) 4. I agree to be a Christian role model for the children by using good manners, using appropriate indoor and outdoor behavior, and treating others with dignity.

5. I agree not to place myself in the position of being alone in a room with any child for my own safety and the safety of the children.

(YOUTH) 6. I agree to encourage the responsible behavior of my peers, who have also agreed to assist with Vacation Bible School.
