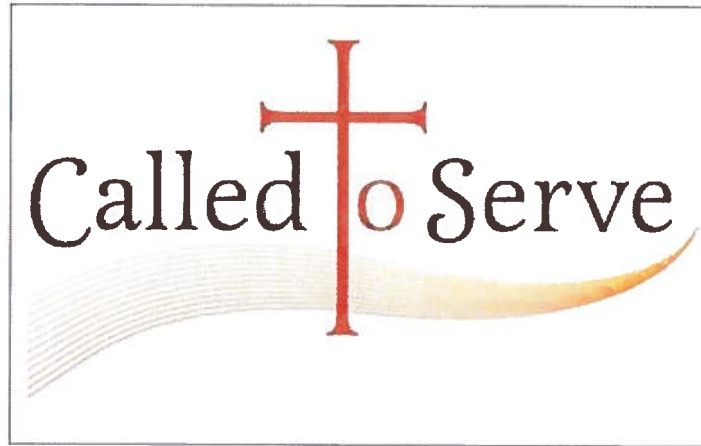

St. Joan of Arc School Commission is a group of parents/parishioners that meets monthly with our Principal to advise her on matters of policy, and to give her feedback on what is working, and not working, at our school.
