Dear Families,

Thank you so much to all of you that came to or helped with our pancake breakfast last weekend! We had a great morning and a nice turnout to share in fellowship while breaking bread together. 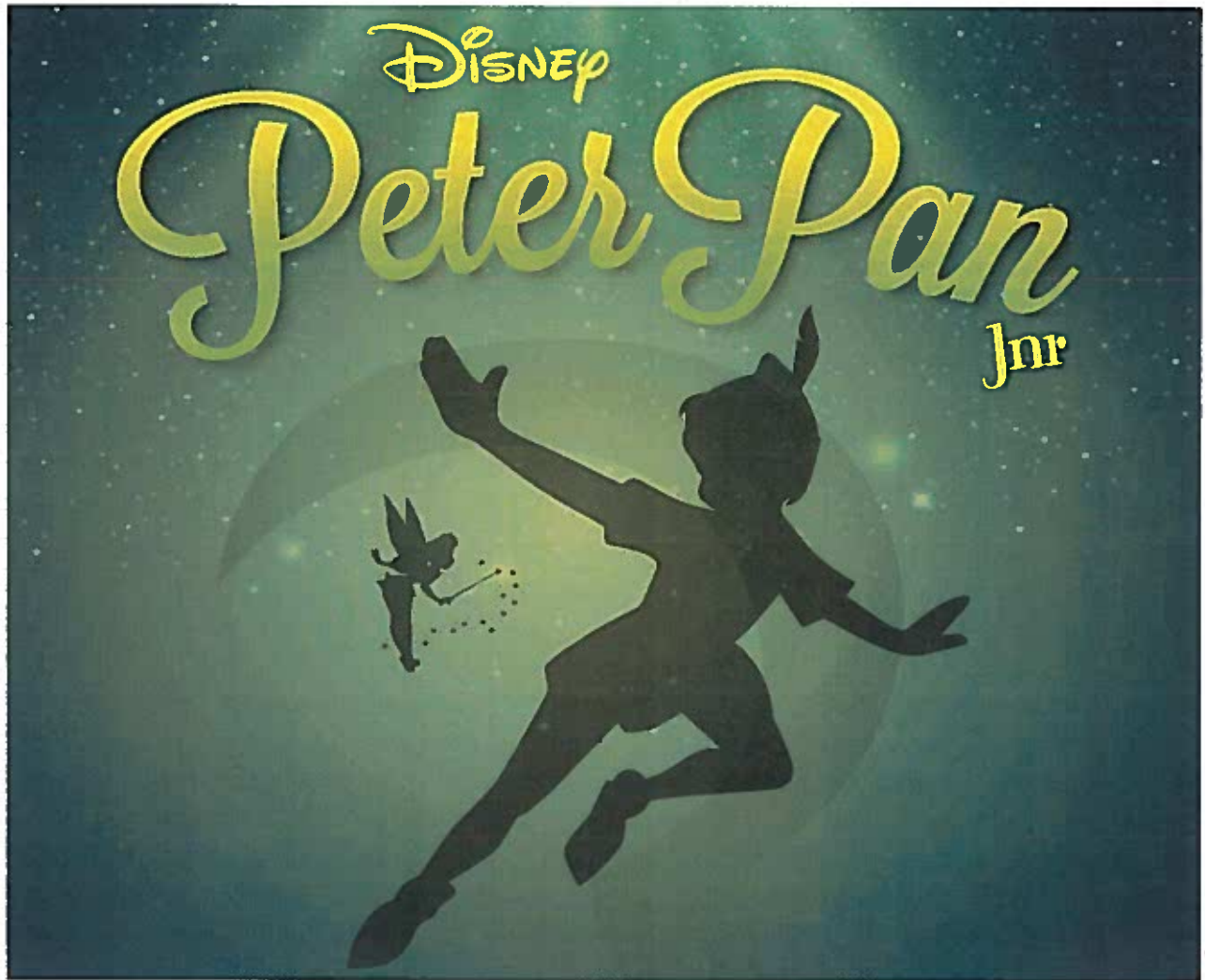
