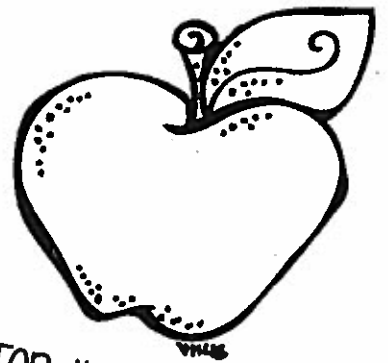

Physical Education

- JK/SK are working on the ball skills of rolling a ball with and without a target. We will be doing activities incorporating this skill.
- Grades 1-8 will be starting the Basketball unit. Grades 1/2 will be focusing on the skills of dribbling a ball and passing techniques. We will be playing games working to master this skill. Grades 3-8 will be working on the same skills, in addition to, strategies and game play in teams.

Health Education

- JK/SK are studying how we dress for the seasons to stay safe and keeping germs away during the cold and flu season.
- 1-2 are learning about Stranger Danger and who they can trust.
- 3-4 are studying safety in a car/bikes and staying safe from violence.
