Dear School Families,

Happy Veteran's Day! We know a number of our school parents and grandparents have served our country as members of our military and we are so thankful to all of you for your service to our country. We hope you feel that gratitude every day, and especially today.

Yesterday I participated in a meeting with the Waukesha County Executive and the Health Department regarding the newest updates to our COVID policies and procedures. The number of cases in Waukesha County, and across our state, are having a drastic increase. In Waukesha County, 42% of all of the cases experienced so far occurred in October. According to the meeting with the health department the number of cases is doubling at a rate for every 2-6 weeks and hospitalization rates are increasing as well. The Governor also held a press conference last night and in that press conference urged Wisconsin residents to stay home and signing an order urging all to stay home and find safe ways to celebrate the coming holidays.

Our goal and driving force has been keeping children in classrooms for face-to-face instruction as much as we can. In order to be able to do this, we really need your cooperation. Our local health department verifies that, to date, there have not been any cases of student-to-student transmission that have occurred in our school. This is a testament to the success of the measures our school has taken. Travel plans and having large dinners/visits with extended family, especially for the coming holidays, are likely to continue the spread of COVID-19. We would kindly ask that you prayerfully keep in mind that the plans you make will impact our school community and ability to be in person for face-to-face instruction. I am going to send out an anonymous survey later today or early tomorrow to help us to plan/prepare for the holidays ahead.

I know that COVID-19 and the response is a sensitive and polarizing issue. Our school will continue to uphold the recommendations and mandates that are set forth as well as to make decisions that support healthy children in school for face-to-face instruction. When we request your child to go home due to signs of illness or for you to contact your healthcare provider, it is in the spirit of preventing spread through our school. Thank you for your cooperation, support, and understanding.

Today our report cards will be sent out. As shared last week, this will be the first sent with the new Archdiocese report card and the switch to standards based grading. We will see the biggest difference in the report cards for grades 5 and above. Though it has been sent in a number of formats over the last months, please do note that there is no achievement grade (A,B,C,D) but there will be standards markings to help you know how your child is moving through mastery of the standards. Your children's teachers will be ready to help walk you through this information in your conferences.

Tomorrow there will be an early release from school and there will be no school on Friday due to Parent Teacher Conferences. There will be no aftercare available due to staff needing to be in conferences. You will receive e-notification of

your conference date/time as well as the Zoom link to sign in to your conference.

With all of the "in and out" related to attendance this year, we have been working hard to work with you for hot lunches. Our lunch program indicates we will not give any refunds due to the need for us to place the order in advance of the school day that lunch is eaten (we send in a Friday order on Tuesday). That said, we always either order the food and allow for you to pick up or issue a credit, depending upon the situation. With grades 3 and 4 out for the week and that being known, there will be a credit issued rather than ask all of you to pick up lunches that were ordered. We will be in touch via emails regarding either credits or lunches available for pick up.

While on the topic of lunches, I want to give a huge thank you to Subway at Pabst Farms. We have been working with the Subway at I-94 and 83 in Delafield for our lunches and due to the tactical situation last week, nearly found ourselves in a bind. Pabst Farms Subway was so kind as to take in our order only an hour before lunch, and have everything ready so all of our students present that day received the lunch that was ordered. Thank you to Subway at Pabst Farms! It also goes without saying that we are incredibly thankful to our local law enforcement for all of their efforts in keeping everyone safe. I want to give a special mention to school parent and Dispatcher James Korsmo for working with me as I made decisions regarding children in school and keeping them safe that day. Thank you, Mr. Korsmo!

Next week will be a traditional school week and then the following will be Thanksgiving. For Thanksgiving, we will have off of school Thursday through Monday. Thursday and Friday are off for the holiday and then Monday as teachers continue their religious education certification classes. That week we will also have pick up of pies from our Elegant Farmer pie sale. We will be in touch regarding the pickup time windows and logistical plans.
