How to Pray the Rosary

Many of us know how to pray the Rosary, but for those who may be unfamiliar with it, here is a quick guide from the *Rosary Center* website:

The Rosary consists of five decades. Each decade consists of one "Our Father," ten "Hail Mary's," one "Glory Be," and the "Fatima Prayer."

On each decade we pray and meditate on the corresponding set of five Mysteries from one of the following groups of mysteries:

- Joyful Mysteries
- Sorrowful Mysteries
- Glorious Mysteries
- Luminous Mysteries

1. Make the Sign of the Cross and say the "Apostles Creed."
2. Say the "Our Father."
3. Say three "Hail Mary's."
4. Say the "Glory be to the Father."
5. Announce the First Mystery; then say the "Our Father."
6. Say ten "Hail Mary's," while meditating on the Mystery.
7. Say the "Glory be to the Father."

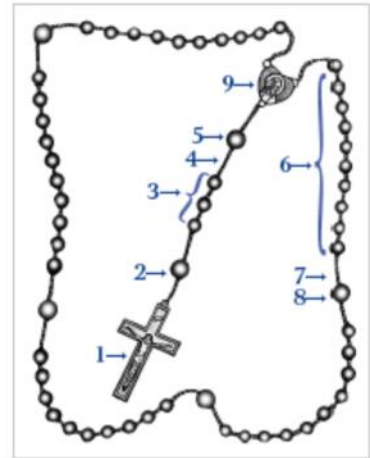
After each decade say the following prayer requested by the Blessed Virgin Mary at Fatima:

"O my Jesus, forgive us our sins, save us from the fires of hell, lead all souls to Heaven, especially those in most need of Thy mercy."

8. Announce the Second Mystery: then say the "Our Father." Repeat 6 and 7 and continue with the Third, Fourth, and Fifth Mysteries in the same manner.

9. Say the 'Hail, Holy Queen' on the medal after the five decades are completed.

10. Conclude with the Sign of the Cross.

1. Haz el Signo de la Cruz y di el "Credo del Apóstol".

5. Anunciar el primer misterio; entonces di el "Padre Nuestro".
6. Di diez "Ave María's", mientras meditas en el Misterio.
7. Di el "Gloria al Padre".

Después de cada década, di la siguiente oración solicitada por la Santísima Virgen María en Fátima:

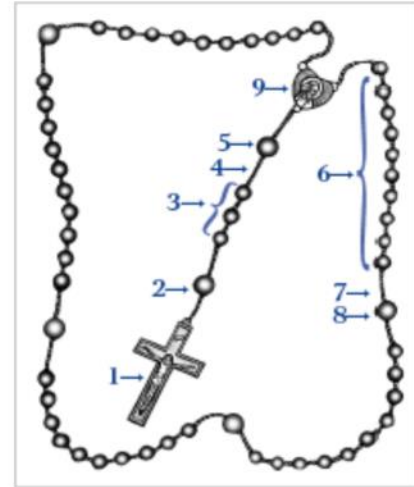
