





During this winter season, if you are feeling ill with a cold or the flu, it is better for you to stay at home and get well rather than come to Mass. With regard to the Precious Blood, we will not be suspending it during this time, but if you are sick or concerned about becoming sick, it is perfectly fine to refrain from consuming it.

Short Story of St. Valentine

St. Valentine is no longer on the Church's calendar because there are three different men who all share the same name and information on them is sparse. One of them was an Italian doctor who later became a priest. He was sent to jail for performing weddings for couples during a time when new marriages were outlawed in the ancient Rome. Before he was killed (about the year 270) for refusing to renounce his faith, he sent a loving note to a child he had been helping to teach, the daughter of his jailer. This may have led to the tradition of sending Valentine's cards. The romantic nature of Valentine's Day may have also been derived during the Middle Ages, when it was believed that birds paired in mid-February. Likewise, Valentine's Day was most likely created to supersede the pagan holiday *Lupercalia*, which was an ancient festival celebrated in Rome to avert evil spirits and purify the city, releasing health and fertility.

Con respecto a la Preciosa Sangre, no la suspenderemos durante este tiempo, pero si usted está enfermo o preocupado por enfermarse, está perfectamente bien abstenerse de consumirla.

Historia Corta de San Valentín

San Valentín ya no está en el calendario de la Iglesia porque hay tres hombres diferentes que comparten el mismo nombre y la información sobre ellos es escasa. Uno de ellos fue un médico italiano que más tarde se convirtió en sacerdote. Fue enviado a la cárcel por realizar bodas para parejas durante un tiempo en que los nuevos matrimonios fueron prohibidos en la antigua Roma. Antes de ser asesinado (alrededor del año 270) por negarse a renunciar a su fe, envió una nota amorosa a un niño que había estado ayudando a enseñar, la hija de su carcelero. Esto puede haber llevado a la tradición de enviar tarjetas de San Valentín. La naturaleza romántica del Día de San Valentín también puede haberse derivado durante la Edad Media, cuando se creía que las aves se emparejaron a mediados de febrero. Del mismo modo, el Día de San Valentín fue creado para reemplazar la fiesta pagana *Lupercalia*, que era un antiguo festival celebrado en Roma para evitar espíritus malignos y purificar la ciudad, liberando salud y fertilidad.
