

- **Education** by providing Catholic schools and Religious Education programs in parishes with the tools needed to share our Catholic faith with people of all ages.
- **Stewardship and Pastoral Services** by providing parish leaders with the resources to help grow vibrant parishes.
- The Compass Newspaper which provides news and information to educate people about the Catholic faith.
- Ministry Formation which provides training and formation to deacons and lay ministers.

This year the goal for St. Joseph Parish is **\$22,041**, which is \$542 less than the goal for 2019 which was \$22,583. Last year we exceeded our goal by \$4,185! We are happy to report that we have already received \$8,391.00 in donations, which means we have \$13,650.00 to go to make our goal. We are already 38% of our way there! 91-93 cents out of every dollar raised goes to diocesan ministries and services right here in northeastern Wisconsin.






Colecta Anual 2020
