



Lenten Reflection Opportunity

When Jesus went to the Garden of Gethsemane to pray, he asked three of his disciples to keep watch with him. But after praying an hour he returned to them only to find them sleeping.



Three times! The spirit is often willing but the flesh is weak. Lent is a good time to grow in our spirituality. You will have the opportunity to do so by attending a Lenten Reflection given by Deacon Paul. The topic is "Journeying through Lent and Life with Jesus" and it will take about an hour of your time. The presentation will be offered twice so that you have a choice of times to attend: **9:00 a.m. on Monday, March 23rd** in church or **6:00 p.m. on Wednesday, March 25th** in the parish hall. Your job will be to make time on your calendar to join with other parishioners in coming to the Lenten Reflection. Deacon Paul's job will be to keep you awake for an hour during our journey with Jesus this Lent. Together, we can do it!

This week there is a flyer in the bulletin with information concerning poverty in Waushara County. Please take the time to read it, especially about the Backpack Nutrition Program. As we embark into Lent 2020, **We ARE in Christ** encourages participation to raise funds for the Backpack program. Flu Precautions


With increased concerns about the flu and coronavirus, if you are feeling ill with a cold or the flu, it is better for you to stay at home and get well rather than come to Mass. Also, if you do not wish to shake hands with someone during the Sign of Peace, you do not have to. Simply say something like: "Peace be with you." With regard to the Precious Blood, we will not be suspending it during this time, but if you are sick or concerned about becoming sick, it is perfectly fine to refrain from consuming it. **We also ask that those who take Holy Communion to the sick or shut-ins please sanitize their hands before opening the tabernacle.**
