



When Jesus went to the Garden of Gethsemane to pray, he asked three of his disciples to keep watch with him. But after praying an hour he returned to them only to find them sleeping.

Three times! The spirit is often willing but the flesh is weak. Lent is a good time to grow in our spirituality. We will have Stations of the Cross every Friday of Lent, except Good Friday, at 5:30 P.M. We will use a different style of the Stations each Friday. Everyone is welcome.



#### Flu Precautions

With increased concerns about the flu and coronavirus, if you are feeling ill with a cold or the flu, it is better for you to stay at home and get well rather than come to Mass. Also, if you do not wish to shake hands with someone during the Sign of Peace, you do not have to. Simply say something like: "Peace be with you." With regard to the Precious Blood, we will not be suspending it during this time, but if you are sick or concerned about becoming sick, it is perfectly fine to refrain from consuming it. We also ask that those who take Holy Communion to the sick or shut-ins please sanitize their hands before opening the tabernacle.
